Dear Residents,

Further to my memo this morning, I am writing you to give you an update with regards to COVID-19.

As a result of our COVID-19 swab testing this week, one of our Part-Time PSWs has tested positive for COVID-19 and is currently in quarantine at their home.

The PSW who tested positive was asymptomatic meaning they did not exhibit any signs of the virus. In addition to implementing our Outbreak Procedures and Infection Control before the testing we have now quarantined our residents until all of the testing results have been returned.

Public Health has informed us that we might not receive all of the results from the residents, staff and support staff until Sunday May 24<sup>th</sup>.

Once we receive the final results we will be able to provide you with a big picture and next steps. My hope is Public Health will allow us to quarantine our Assisted suites for 14 Days and open our Independent suites.

This will mean, our independent residents could move freely on our property and throughout the building with a mask.

In the meantime, please stay in your suites. All meals will be provided in your suite. Please notify reception if you have any maintenance, laundry or housekeeping concerns.

I will provide you with more information as it becomes available.
