Dear Residents and Family Members,

I hope this update finds everyone safe and healthy. We have been diligently monitoring the COVID-19 cases in Ontario this week. The cases have been trending upwards for the past 8 days. We are anticipating a spike in cases throughout Ontario due to back to school.

I feel presentation Manor needs to be proactive in modifying our visitation policy until we can see exactly how the back to school season will affect us.

With this in mind, we are implementing the following protocols, so that we may keep our residents and employees safe:

- Beginning Tuesday, September 8, Presentation Manor will no longer allow in-suite visits with a resident. All visits inside Presentation Manor will occur within a designated area assigned by reception. The designated areas inside Presentation Manor will **accommodate 2 visitors at a time**, including the resident. The booking system will be updated on Monday with the new designated indoor areas.

- The outside social circles will continue to accommodate a maximum of 10 visitors, who are now **required to have a valid negative COVID-19 test.**

We will swab you for COVID-19, whether it is our regular testing day or not.



All of our employees will be attending a COVID-19 preparedness meeting to remind everyone of our protocols and infection control measures.

We have reached out to Michael Garron Hospital to ask for an Infection Prevention Control Team to audit our measures before the cold and flu season is upon us.
