Dear Residents and Family Members,

I am writing to provide you with a COVID-19 update. Presentation Manor has received all of the test results from earlier this week.

I am pleased to report that all results for both staff and residents have returned negative. In consultation with Michael Garron Hospital we have been able to lift the quarantine measures for 1st floor and 2nd floor residents only.

Residents on the 3rd floor and 4th floor will have to remain in quarantine. The reason for this is that the resident who tested positive (and remains positive with mild symptoms) ate in the communal dining room with 4th floor residents.

We want to be absolutely sure that, before they leave their suites, none of our residents in quarantine are incubating COVID-19 and potentially infectious to others.

Our nursing team will test (swab) residents in quarantine beginning at 10 AM. Sunday November 22. Once the results are returned indicating everyone is negative, we will then lift the quarantine for 3rd floor and 4th floor. The earliest date will likely be Tuesday November 24.

I'm sorry my news does not please everyone, but it is imperative that we keep everyone as safe and healthy as possible during these uncertain times.
