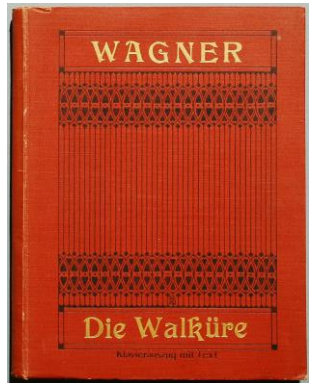

The vocal powerhouse of Christine Goerke raised her artistry to the next level at the end of the 2018-19 season, singing the impetuous warrior maiden, Brünnhilde, in three full cycles of

Richard Wagner's epic Ring cycle. In this Live in HD production of Die Walküre, the second and most popular installment in the composer's sweeping tetralogy, Goerke is joined by bass-baritone Greer Grimsley as Brünnhilde's godly father, Wotan, and mezzo-soprano Jamie Barton as his unbending wife, Fricka. As the incestuous-lovers Siegmund and Sieglinde, soprano Eva-Maria Westbroek and tenor Stuart Skelton – alongside bass Günther Groissböck as Sieglinde's bloodthirsty husband, Hunding – round out the principal cast. And on the podium, Maestro Philippe Jordan conducts Robert Lepage's innovative staging, which uses state-of-the-art stage technology to tell Wagner's mythical tale.

Climate Action Talk- Kehkashan Basu



Kehkashan Basu is the founder of the Green Hope Foundation, which is focused on giving a voice to children and youth in a discussion that arguably impacts them the most – the future. She is passionate about sustainability, inter and intragenerational equality, girls and women's rights, and climate justice. Speaking at several United Nations and international summits, Kehkashan continues to share her message far and wide encouraging today's youth to participate in and engage in a world that is building their future.

She has received international recognition including for 2016 International Children's Peace Prize, the 2017 Turner Prize for Social Change and the 2017 National Energy Globe Award, and was elected Global Coordination for the United Nations Environment Program – achieving all of this before she has even reached the age of 18. Kehkashan has spoken at several global conferences, such as COP23, the 34th Session of the United Nations Human Rights Council in Geneva, the World Bank Youth Forum, the European Parliament's session on gender equality, HLPF sessions at UN New York, the 2018 Globe Forum in Vancouver and most recently at the 2018 St. Louis Climate Summit.
